SUBJECT: Award Recommendation – Requests for Qualifications Part A: Pre-Site Restoration Services and Part B: Site Restoration Services (Construction Management at Risk) Project No. 431-PA27-001 and Project No. 431-PA27-002

The Selection Review Committee has evaluated the responses submitted to the Requests for Qualifications in accordance with the evaluation factors set forth in the Requests for Qualifications. Eight (8) proposers submitted responses to the RFQs: Dynamic Group, Carbon Reduction Solutions, M&A Resources, Lemoine, Milestone Project Services, Garner, Promethean Energy, and 360 Consulting.

Each Selection Review Committee member evaluated each response in an objective and unbiased manner.

The Selection Review Committee convened on Thursday, July 16, 2026. Of the eight (8) responses received, four (4) were deemed non-responsive: Carbon Reduction Solutions, M&A Resources, Promethean Energy, and 360 Consulting. The Selection Review Committee scored the four (4) responsive proposals: Lemoine, Dynamic Group, Garner, and Milestone Project Services.¹

After review and scoring, the Selection Review Committee recommends the proposals submitted by Lemoine and Garner as being most advantageous to the State.
